



The Chairman of the International Investors Association of Georgia paid a visit to Mr. Cemal Bilgingulluoglu Owner of Ajara Textile and Honorary Chairman of the International Investors Association of Georgia. During the meeting, the sides discussed the current problems caused by the pandemic in the world and in our country, discussed the importance of various environmental factors for attracting new investments, various obstacles for foreign investors to invest in Georgia and ways to solve them. Also, the chairman of the association congratulated Mr. Jemal on the opening of a new factory "Kartli Textile" in Rustavi and wished him success in his future activities. Total amount of investment will be GEL 20 mln and at full capacity employee 4,000 individuals, with 90% of them being women. Kartli Textile is affiliate of "Adjara Textile", which has been operating in Georgia since 2008 and is one of the biggest exporters. Their existing 3 factories, in Batumi, Poti and Bobokvati, already employees more than 3,500 people. Company produces and export about 15 mln units annually.
